On the other side of the paper have your guests write down the number 1 thru 4 and then have them write down four things the bride should take with her on her honeymoon.

Ask the Bride back to the room and tell her that her guests have some advice for her. Then have the guests read out their answers when you ask the following questions.

- 1. What is the most important characteristic of getting along with your husband?
- 2. How long should the honeymoon last?
- 3. What do husbands like best to eat?
- 4. What colours do husbands like best?
- 5. Should the husband be allowed to think he is the boss?
- 6. How many children should be in the house?
- 7. How many rooms should be in the house?
- 8. What are the best household pets?
- 9. What outside interest should a husband be allowed to have?
- 10. What should husbands be expected to do around the house?
- 11. What should a husband give his wife for her birthday?
- 12. What characteristic in a wife is most irritating to a husband?

Now tell the bride that her guests also have some helpful hints as to what she should take with her on her honeymoon. Then have the guests read out their answers.

Give a gift to the guest who said for the bride to bring her husband. That is the prize answer. Be prepared for some ties and bring extra gifts.
